Singapore Cooperation Programme

Singapore has provided technical assistance to other developing countries since the 1960s. As a country whose only resource is its people, Singapore believes that human resource development is vital for economic and social progress. Singapore itself has benefited from training provided by other countries and international organisations.

In 1992, the Singapore Cooperation Programme (SCP) was established to bring together under one framework the various technical assistance programmes offered by Singapore. Through the SCP, the range and number of training programmes were increased to share Singapore's development experience with other developing countries.

To date, close to 150,000 officials from more than 180 countries, territories and intergovernmental organisations have participated in our courses and study visits. The SCP is managed by the Technical Cooperation Directorate of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Singapore.

Course Objectives

This online course is conducted under the auspices of the SCP Training Award.

This course will highlight Singapore's experience in various public policy and service delivery innovations, as well as the capabilities that public services need in order to stay relevant.

Synopsis

Topics to be covered include:

- Singapore's approach to governance and public service transformation
- Challenges and innovations in the formulation of socio-economic policies
- Building a digital economy and a digitally inclusive society
- Use of technology and data to improve public service delivery
- The public service as a platform for citizenry engagement and ground-up innovation

Methodology

This course will be conducted in English for up to 30 participants through synchronous e-learning ('live' e-learning sessions), and could include asynchronous e-learning (self-study e.g. reading materials). There will be Q&A sessions and facilitated group discussions during the 'live' e-learning sessions.

Regulations

Participants are required to comply with the following:

- Strictly observe course schedules and not miss training sessions; and
- Carry out instructions and abide by conditions as may be stipulated by the nominating authority or government and the Government of Singapore and its appointed trainer, with respect to the course.



Duration

The course will be held over five days from <u>12 to 16</u> June 2023.

The 'live' e-learning sessions will be tentatively conducted from 1400H to 1800H (Singapore time; UTC/GMT +08:00 hours) daily. The programme schedule will be provided to successful applicants closer to the start of course.

Attendance will be taken for the 'live' e-learning sessions.

Application Information

Applicants should be:

- Mid- to senior-level government officials involved in leading and overseeing public sector reforms;
- Able to attend <u>all</u> the synchronous e-learning sessions (participants will require an internetenabled device with Zoom installed, webcam, microphone and audio);
- Nominated by their respective governments; and
- Proficient in written and spoken English.

Terms of Award

The course is sponsored by the Government of Singapore under the Singapore Cooperation Programme Training Award.

Application Procedure

(Closing date for nomination: 5 May 2023)

The Government of Singapore is pleased to invite the respective National Focal Point for Technical Assistance (NFP) to nominate one (1) suitable applicant. Selection of candidates will be based on merit. Should there be more applicants than training places, the Government of Singapore seeks the understanding of the respective NFP in the event that its nominee(s) is not selected.
