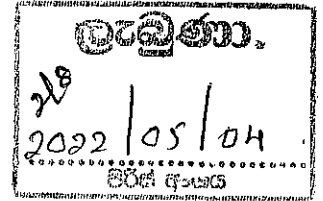
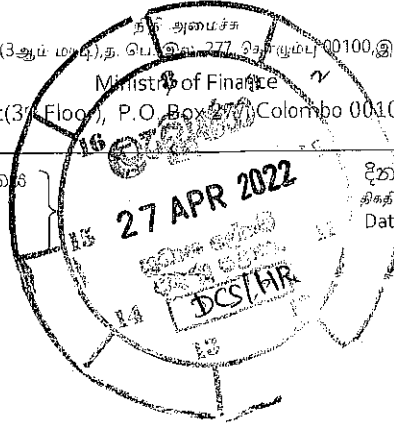

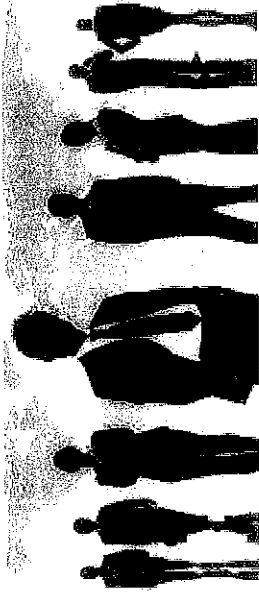
ABOUT SEAMEO RECSAM
