Applicants should carefully adhere to the application procedures stipulated in the 2026 Enrolment Guide.

Applicants are advised to ensure strict compliance with all eligibility criteria specified in the Enrolment Guide, including academic qualifications, age limits, and service requirements, where applicable.

It is also kindly requested that each nomination be duly certified and endorsed by the Head of the respective Department/Institution, confirming that the applicant meets all eligibility requirements and that the nomination is submitted with official concurrence.

Please ensure that complete applications are submitted to ERD on or before **4:00 p.m. on 12 May 2026**. Ministries are kindly requested to complete their internal screening and approval processes sufficiently in advance to facilitate timely submission. Only duly completed applications (items i–vii), received on or before the stipulated deadline, will be considered. Incomplete or non-compliant applications will not be processed.

Applications received by ERD will be forwarded to the Economic and Commercial Office of the Embassy of the People's Republic of China in Sri Lanka for the selection process. Shortlisted candidates will be informed in due course regarding the subsequent steps of the admission process.

For any clarifications relating to the application procedure, applicants may contact the Department of External Resources through the designated focal point of the Ministry/ institution.

Please note that, upon confirmation of selection, nominees are expected to honour their acceptance and refrain from withdrawal except under exceptional and unavoidable circumstances. As these opportunities are extended for the benefit of the country, withdrawals after selection may adversely affect Sri Lanka's standing and result in the loss of valuable training opportunities, while depriving other deserving officers. Accordingly, Ministries and applicants are kindly requested to ensure that nominations are submitted only with a firm and unconditional commitment to participate.


The Government of the People's Republic of China will provide a full scholarship covering the following expenses:

# 1. Program Introduction

## (1) Program Description

### **Brief Introduction**

Mofcom Degree Education Programs sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of People's Republic of China started from 2008. It is designed to foster high-end and inter-disciplinary talent working in the applied fields of government, economy and trade, foreign affairs, agriculture, science and technology, education, culture and health, energy resources and transportation, public administration etc building intellectual capacity and facilitating the economic and social development of the recipient countries., offering one-year and two-year master programs as well as three-year doctoral programs. These programs provide assistance to governmental officials, research fellows, and senior managerial personnel on their master and doctor education in China, which are fully conducted in English. Admission requirements include a bachelor's degree, relevant working experiences, and decent physical conditions, essential for the high-compact curriculum needed for the degrees.

The program plays an increasingly significant role in the economic development cooperation between China and students' home countries, and is highly valued by the government of students' home countries.

Hunan University has started the two-year master program sponsored by Ministry of Commerce since 2015. It specializes in Industrial Engineering and Management in 2026, taught in English.

### **Prospective Students**

Our prospective students are mid-to-senior level officials or managers from the government, the media, NGOs, and other public sectors, who have demonstrated superior performance, both academically and in their work.

### **Program Objective**

To prepare high-level, compound and applied talents in the field of politics, economy and trade, diplomacy, agriculture, science& education& culture& public health, energy resources and transportation, public administration for developing countries.

### **Enrollment Plan:**

In 2026 we have planned to enroll up to 25 students in our master program with a concentration on Industrial Engineering and Management. The program duration is 2 years and the instruction language is English.

### **Financial Aid**

- a. Students are exempt from tuition fee, teaching materials fees, research fees, English teaching grants, graduation thesis guidance fee;
- b. University will provide free accommodation;
- c. The living expense 36000RMB/per year will be monthly deposited to students account by the university based on the students' actual residence time in China;
- d. The settlement allowance being 3000 RMB/person will be given to students account by the university;
- e. University will buy comprehensive medical insurance for students;
- f. Two round-trip international air tickets will be provided. One is for you come to register in the university and for you back home after graduation; The other one is for you to go back home to visit your families during the summer or winter vocation;
- g. Students are required to take part in the Annual Evaluation. Those who meet the criteria can continue to enjoy full scholarship in the following year.
- h. The Ministry of Commerce subsidizes the university related expenses for its teaching and managing. Only the settlement allowance and the living expenses should be granted to the students, and other fees will be managed by Ministry of Commerce or by the university, not to be granted to the students.

The Ministry of Commerce only provides students with financial support during the school system (two-years for master students). The students who postponed their graduation will not receive the continuing support.

## **(2)Introduction to Hunan University**

### **Brief Introduction**

Hunan University (HNU) is a national key university directly under the Ministry

of Education. It has been included in the national "Project 211" and "Project 985," and shortlisted for China's construction plan of world-class universities and first-class disciplines ("Double First-Class University" initiative)."

HNU traces its origins to Yuelu Academy, which was founded in 976 AD. In 1903, Yuelu Academy merged with the Hunan Institute of Higher Learning, which can be traced back to Shiwu School established in 1897, and then was officially renamed Hunan University in 1926. In 1937, HNU was designated as one of the 16 state universities. After the founding of the People's Republic of China in 1949, Li Da, one of the major founders and early leaders of the Communist Party of China, was appointed as the first president of HNU. Late Chairman Mao Zedong inscribed the name of the university. In 2000, HNU and the Hunan Institute of Finance and Economics merged to form the HNU of today.

The full-time students total more than 40,000, of which over 23,000 are undergraduates, and 17,000 are postgraduates.

HNU has 37 educational and research institutions, providing academic subjects in 13 professional disciplines—philosophy, economics, law, education, literature, history, science, engineering, management, medicine, agronomy, arts, and interdiscipline. HNU offers 87 undergraduate programs, 40 first-level disciplines authorized to confer master's degrees, and 36 first-level disciplines to confer doctorates. Chemistry, mechanical engineering, and electric engineering are listed as "world-class disciplines" of the Ministry of Education. The Marxism School has been recognized as a national key school of Marxism. Five disciplines rank among the ESI global top 1‰, while engineering discipline among the global top 1‰. In 2025, HNU ranked 43rd globally in the Nature Index ranking.

HNU has a staff of more than 4,270, of whom over 2,393 are full-time teachers. The HNU faculty has received 372 national high-level talent awards and 275 national awards for high-level young researchers, including six full-time memberships in the Chinese Academy of Sciences and the Chinese Academy of Engineering and five winners of the National Outstanding Teacher Award. HNU has seven innovative research groups supported by the Natural Science Foundation of China (NSFC), one inaugural philosophy and social science innovation team approved by the Ministry of Education, one innovative team recognized by the State Administration of Science, Technology and Industry for National Defence, 14 national-level teaching groups, and four candidates for the national Huang Danian-style Teacher Teams.

Hunan University, since 1998, has started to enroll international students for 28 years. In 2025, Hunan University has more than 600 international students from over 80 countries.

### **College of Mechanical and Vehicle Engineering**

College of Mechanical and Vehicle Engineering originates from Mechanical Department in 1908, which is one of the time-renowned colleges in Hunan University.

There are 2 first-order disciplines authorized to confer Ph.D degrees and with post-doctoral research centers which are Mechanical Engineering and Mechanics, 8 second-order disciplines authorized to confer Ph.D degrees, and 2 post-doctoral research programs; 11 disciplines authorized to confer Master's degree and 2 professional master's degree authorizations. Mechanical Engineering is a first-order national key program and is listed as "world-class discipline" of the Ministry of Education. There are 2 national scientific research bases including National Engineering Research Center for High Efficiency Grinding and State Key Laboratory of Advanced Design and Manufacturing Technology for Vehicle. And 11 provincial and ministerial scientific research bases.

The college offers seven undergraduate majors: Mechanical Design, Manufacturing, and Automation; Vehicle Engineering; Energy and Power Engineering; Industrial Engineering; Engineering Mechanics; Intelligent Manufacturing Engineering; Intelligent Vehicle Engineering. It currently has 257 faculty members, including 2 Chinese Academy of Engineering (CAE) members, 76 professors, and 81 associate professors, ensuring a strong faculty and stable academic team. The college enrolls over 3,900 students, with more than 1,900 postgraduates and over 2,000 undergraduates.

### **Campus Life**

Hunan University is located in Changsha, capital city of Hunan province. Changsha is located in the northeast of Hunan province. It is a subtropical monsoon humid climate, characterized by mild climate, abundant precipitation, rain and heat in the same period and four seasons. Summer and winter are long, spring and autumn are short. Temperature of Spring is 8 °C -15 °C, summer 23 °C -30 °C, autumn 20 °C -29 °C, winter 5 °C -12 °C, and annual average temperature is 17.2 degrees Celsius.

HNU currently consists of two campuses-the South Campus and the North Campus, occupying a total area of 1.5433 million square meters. A new campus, the

Kechuanggang Campus is under construction, spanning about 1.067 million square meters. Students apartments are located in South campus, North campus, Tianma residential area and Dezhiyuan residential area.

International students live in the International Students Apartment of Dezhiyuan in Dezhiyuan residential area. Students for Master of Industrial Engineering and Management program will be offered a single room equipped with washing room, air-condition, refrigerator, television, network. Public kitchen and laundry are arranged on each floor. Student canteen including Halal canteen is distributed in Dezhiyuan residential area.

### Teaching Methods

Our master degree program is a 2-year full-time program. Students enrolled in this program are expected to complete the coursework, conduct research, and write a thesis within 2 years.

All the courses incorporate seminars, lectures, discussions and field works, which are all instructed in English.

### Lessons

48 periods for each course;

45 minutes for each period.

### **Discussion**

Under the guidance of teachers, the whole class or a small group give their opinions and views around one topic and inspired by each other. One question should be raised each month.

### **Field Study**

During Study, our college will arrange academic activities including academic reports by Local Government officials, industrial managerial personals, industry associations chairman and scholars from universities. Students will also be invited to join internship and investigations in established enterprises of mechanical engineering, track traffic, vehicle manufacturing and special equipment.

### **Thesis**

After getting full credits required by the university, a student should choose a professor as his/her supervisor, and determine the subject matter for thesis proposal on the basis of a real world problem to be solved in his/her own countries. If the thesis proposal is approved by the supervisor and the college, students are expected to complete their thesis with no less than 20000 words and apply for an oral defense.

### **Awarding Degree**

A master degree in the field of Industrial Engineering and Management will be conferred upon a candidate after his/her successful completion of required credits and thesis.

## 2. How to Apply

### (1) Qualifications of Application

Applicants should:

- a) Be in compliance with the laws and regulations of the People's Republic of China (PRC) and the university regulations, and respect Chinese customs and habits;
- b) Be non-Chinese nationality from developing countries under the age of 45 (born after 1 Sep, 1981) and be healthy;
- c) Be physically and mentally healthy with the Health Certificate or Physical Examination Result issued by local public hospitals. Without diseases classified as "prohibited entry into China" under Chinese laws and regulations and without diseases classified as "prohibition of long-term residency in China"; Without serious Chronic diseases such as hypertension, cardio-cerebral vascular disease, diabetes, cancers etc; Without Psychiatric diseases; Without Infectious diseases which may bring great harm to the public health; Not in the recovery period after a major operation; Not in the acute episode of the acute disease; Not severely disabled. Pregnant women are not allowed to attend this program in China. If you are pregnant during your studies in China, you will be dropped out of school.
- d) Hold a Bachelor's degree or above and with 3 years or more working experience ;
- e) The applicants with profession studying or working background related to the major applied and be on the job are preferred.
- f) To serve as Public officer (section chief or corresponding levels and above) of the government departments of the host country, Or Senior managers of various institutions and enterprises, Or Academic backbone of the universities and scientific research institutions.
- g) Have a good command of English, proficiency in English for academic courses (For example IELTS 6.0 or TOEFL 80);
- h) With the potential of career development in this field and with the intention to promote friendly exchanges and cooperation between China and the host country;
- i) The applicants who are studying in China or have been admitted to other programs of Chinese government scholarship are not allowed to apply;
- j) Preferred (not limited to) academic background are mechanical engineering, industrial engineering and management, information engineering, electrical engineering, mathematics, physics, management science, economics and

accounting;

- k) Only applicants recommended by the Economic and Commercial Counselor’s Office of Chinese Embassy in the country that accords with the candidate’s nationality will be considered.

## (2)Application Procedure

### Application to Hunan University with Mofcom Scholarship

b) Please visit the online application system of Hunan University at <http://hnu.17gz.org/>, register and log in for online application. Successively choose the program “Chinese Government Scholarship”, “Master Student”, “College of Mechanical and Vehicle Engineering”, “Industrial Engineering and Management”, fill in all the information required, upload all the application materials required, and click “submit” to finish the online application procedure.

c) To complete the online application successfully, please note the following information: the teaching Language is “English”, and the duration of Study is two years from 01/09/2026 to 31/08/2028.

d) For this program, the university will offer Professional master degree after the students achieve all the requirements. Different from Academic master degree, Professional master degree is to cultivate applied high-level talents with solid theoretical foundation and adapt to the practical needs of the industry, which is also a form of master education in China.

Other special requests if any.

**Reminders:**

a) All the documents to be submitted should be in Chinese or English. Otherwise, a notarized copy in Chinese or English is required.

b) An original copy of degrees, transcripts and language certificates must be presented for on-site verification. After verification, students themselves should send the documents to the university.

## **MOFCOM SCHOLARSHIP-CSC Program (2026 Enrollment Guide)**

### **Part one: Program Introduction**

#### **I Brief Introduction**

Academic Education Programs sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of People's Republic of China is designed to foster high-end business officials and managerial personnel for the recipient countries, offering master programs and doctoral programs for the purpose of educating high-end and inter-disciplinary talent working in the applied fields of government, trade, foreign affairs, agriculture, technology, education, culture and health, building intellectual capacity and facilitating the economic and social development of the recipient countries. These programs provide assistance to governmental officials, research fellows, and senior managerial personnel on their master and doctor education in China, which are fully conducted in English. Admission requirements include a bachelor's degree or master degree, relevant working experiences, and decent physical conditions, essential for the high-compact curriculum needed for the degrees. The programs are playing a more and more important role in stimulating economic cooperation between China and students' home countries, which the host governments are attaching great attention to this program.

MOFCOM Scholarship-CSC Program is set up by Ministry of Commerce of People's Republic of China to further strengthen the communication and cooperation between China and other countries as well as to develop talents for developing countries. Starting from 2015, MOFCOM Scholarship-CSC Program mainly sponsors the young and the middle-aged talents from recipient countries to pursue their postgraduate degree education in China. China Scholarship Council is entrusted to administer the Scholarship.

#### **II Supporting categories**

MOFCOM Scholarship-CSC Program supports Master program and PhD program.

#### **III Educational purpose**

To cultivate high-level, versatile and application-oriented talents in the fields of politics, economy and trade, diplomacy, agriculture, science, education, culture and health, energy and transportation, and public administration.

#### **IV Enrollment Plan**

Designated universities and majors of this program is included in the attachment. Length of scholarship will be settled when admission is completed, which accords to the enrolled length of schooling, which shall be 2 or 3 years for Master Recipients and 3 or 4 year for PHD Recipients. Scholarship recipients must register for English-taught program.

#### **V Scholarship Coverage**

1. Students are exempt from tuition fee, teaching material fee, research and survey fee, allowance of English-taught program, dissertation guidance fee;

2. Free on-campus accommodation;
3. Monthly stipend:
  - 36000RMB per year per master student,
  - 42000RMB per year per PhD student;
- ※ *Stipends will be distributed to the students by the universities on a monthly basis according to the students' actual time spent in China.*
4. One-off resettlement fee: 3000RMB per person;
5. Free medical insurance for international students;
6. One-time round-trip international airfare for all the students (First time fly to China after enrollment, and Fly back to home country while graduation), and a maximum of “n-1” (“n” is for the length of schooling year which is set while the student was enrolled by the program) round-trip international airfares for home visits (one time per year set at the end of an academic year);
7. The annual review is compulsory for all students. Those who pass the review may continue to enjoy full scholarships in the next year.
8. Other expenses shall be managed and used by the Ministry of Commerce or the universities as a whole, and shall not be distributed to students. The Ministry of Commerce only provides students with financial support within their enrolled length of schooling. Students who postpone their graduation will not receive the continuing sponsorship.

## **Part Two: How to Apply**

### **I Eligibility**

To be eligible, applicants must:

- be a citizen of a developing country other than the People’s Republic of China, and under the age of 45 (born after September 1, 1981);
- be healthy physically and mentally with a physical examination report issued by a local public hospital, and not having any disease or situation listed below:
  - a) Diseases prohibited by Chinese Entry-Exit Inspection and Quarantine Laws and Regulations
  - b) Other severe chronic diseases like high blood pressure, cardio-cerebrovascular disease, diabetes; psychological diseases; or other infectious diseases which may harm public health
  - c) In recovery period after major surgery or acute disease attacks
  - d) Severe physically challenged
  - e) Pregnancy (Students who become pregnant while studying in China will be expelled)
- with at least three years’ working experience, and be a bachelor’s degree holder when applying for master’s program; be a master’s degree holder when applying for doctoral program;
- be incumbents with a relevant educational background or working experience to the applied program are preferred;

- be public officials of division level and above (or corresponding level) in government sectors, or senior management staff of organizations and enterprises, or academic backbones of universities and research institutions;
- be sufficient in English which meets the academic requirements of the program, be equivalent to IELTS 6.0 or TOEFL 80 and above level;
- be with the potential of professional development, and is committed to promoting the friendly exchanges and cooperation between the host country and China;
- be neither studying in China nor being admitted to other scholarship programs provided by Chinese government.

## **II Application Procedures**

The Economic and Commercial Counselor's Office (ECCO) of the Chinese Embassy in your country will be open for application **until 6<sup>th</sup> June 2026.**

### **Application Online and Documents List**

1. Application Form for MOFCOM Scholarship-CSC Program;  
Ensure you have both submitted it online (visit [www.campuschina.org](http://www.campuschina.org), click "Scholarship Application for Students") and printed the hard copy. For more application instructions, please check Attachment I;
2. Photocopy of highest diploma;
3. Photocopy of academic transcripts;
4. A Study Plan or Research Proposal, plus a resume including the educational background and working experience after high school;
5. Two recommendation letters, including one from current employer and one from academic perspective;
6. Photocopy of the Foreigner Physical Examination Form;
7. Photocopy of the English proficiency certificate;
8. Photocopy of a valid passport;
9. Non-criminal Record Report. The applicant shall submit a valid certificate of Non-Criminal Record issued by the local public security authority, usually issued within 6 months prior to the submission date of the application.

### **Submission Offline**

1. The applicants shall obtain the approval and recommendation from the relevant department of host country before applying for this scholarship. Afterwards, the applicants could submit application according to the requirements of above department.
2. For the applicants whose host government allows them to submit the application directly to the Embassy of China, please obtain the permission or recommendation letter from the host government which states that the applicant has been approved to study in China, and submit the original documents of the letter and other above mentioned application documents to the ECCO of Chinese Embassy in the host country. The scanned electronic edition of the documents is needed as well. For

emails and addresses of the Economic and Commercial Counsellor's Offices, please visit <http://www.mofcom.gov.cn/>.

2. The responsible department of the host government shall submit a written request to the ECCO of Chinese Embassy for an official recommendation letter and clearly state:

- a) Whether the applicant is willing to be considered for a similar program at other universities if the applied programs could not accept the applicant.
- b) Other special requests if any.

**Reminders:**

- a) All the documents to be submitted should be in Chinese or English. Otherwise, a notarized copy in Chinese or English is required.
- b) An original copy of degrees, transcripts, Foreigner Physical Examination Form and language certificates must be presented for on-site verification.
- c) Applicants will get back all the hard-copy materials, both original copies and photocopies from the ECCO of Chinese Embassy. If admitted, students must take the documents to China and submit them to the university for verification and archive.
- d) Bringing spouse or other dependent for accompanying is not allowed during the students' study in China. The scholarship will not provide any related cost;
- e) No explanation will be given on the enrollment result.
- f) Applications without the recommendation from the ECCO of Chinese Embassy will not be considered.

**Part Three: Placement**

Each applicant can choose maximally three preferred universities out of the 26 designated universities. CSC will place each applicant in one university only on the basis of their choices and universities' requirements.

**Part Four: Admission & Registration**

Scholarship winners will receive the admission package from ECCO of the Chinese Embassy after the enrollment result is confirmed, and must register at the host university before the deadline which is usually September, 2026. Regarding the registration and course arrangement for enrolled candidates, please keep in touch with the host universities and closely follow their relevant notices.

**Step 4: Input the correct Agency Number.**
