I. Program Description

1. Basic Information

(1) Introduction

Academic Education Program for developing countries under the Ministry of Commerce of the People's Republic of China (MOFCOM) was established in 2008 by MOFCOM through Chinese Government Programs. The purpose of this program is to cultivate high-end, inter-disciplinary and applied talents for the recipient countries in such fields as politics, trade, foreign affairs, agriculture, technology, education, culture and health, energy and transportation, public management, etc., and to provide intellectual support for recipient countries in their economic and social developments. The Academic Education Program offers one-year or two-year master programs and 3-year doctoral programs, which provide assistance to government officials, research fellows, and senior managerial personnel on their master and doctoral education in China, and are instructed in English. Due to short schooling system, the students are requested to obtain a bachelor degree in advance with some working experience in related fields so that they can better understand the lectures. They are also requested to be in a good health so as to adapt to extensive learning and to obtain the degrees.

This program is playing an increasingly important role in the economic and trade cooperation and development between China and the recipient countries and highly valued by the respective governments.

2026 International Program for Master of International Business (IMIB) organized by Jiangxi University of Finance and Economics (JUFE). It aims to cultivate high-level operation and management talents in the field of international business for developing countries. Jiangxi University of Finance and Economics boasts excellent educational facilities, a strong and experienced faculty team, and extensive expertise in international training and assistance programs. The curriculum of this program has been carefully designed by a team of professional instructors, and it is intended to enhance students' cross-border and cross-cultural business and management capabilities within an open and dynamic learning environment.

(2) Prospective Students

This program is designed for middle to senior-level business management officials from developing countries, middle to senior-level executives and managers from foreign-related enterprises, as well as outstanding business researchers from relevant universities and research institutions. Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree or above.

(3) Program Objective

To cultivate high-level, interdisciplinary, and practice-oriented professionals with a global perspective for developing countries in the fields of politics, economy and trade, diplomacy, agriculture, science and technology, education, culture, health, energy, transportation, and public administration.

(4) Enrollment Plan

We plan to enroll 30 students for International Program for Master of International Business (IMIB) with two years of full-time schooling and English is the language of instruction.

(5) Financial Aid

- ① Tuition fees, textbook materials, field trip fees, English tuition fees, and thesis supervision fees are waived.
- ② On-campus accommodation is provided free of charge.
- ③ A living allowance will be granted: 36,000 yuan per master's student per year. JUFU will distribute the allowance to students on a monthly basis and regularly according to their actual time spent on campus.
- ④ A one-time settlement allowance of 3,000 yuan per person will be provided.
- ⑤ The university will purchase a comprehensive medical insurance for international students coming to China on their behalf.
- ⑥ Round-trip international air tickets will be provided free of charge: For students with a one-year program, one round-trip air ticket will be provided; for students with a program of more than two years, one round-trip air ticket will be provided, and n-1 (where n is the number of academic years) round-trip air tickets for home visits during the academic years will also be provided.
- ⑦ All degree students must participate in the annual evaluation, and those who meet the evaluation criteria can continue to have the full scholarships.

⑧ Other fees will be managed and used by the Ministry of Commerce and JUFÉ in a coordinated manner and will not be distributed to students. The Ministry of Commerce only provides funding within the prescribed length of study for students. Those who postpone their graduation cannot get further funding.

2. About the Organizer

(1) About Jiangxi University of Finance and Economics (JUFÉ)

Jiangxi University of Finance and Economics was founded in 1923 and is located in Nanchang, Jiangxi Province, China. It is a higher education institution jointly established by the Ministry of Finance, the Ministry of Education, and the Jiangxi Provincial People's Government. With a focus on economics and management disciplines, it also promotes the coordinated development of disciplines such as law, engineering, liberal arts, science, agriculture, education, philosophy, history, and art. Jiangxi University of Finance and Economics holds a leading position in the fields of economics and management, ranking seventh among all finance and economics universities in China.

The university adheres to its financial and economic characteristics, opening up new development spaces through its strategic plans. It accelerates the transformation and construction of a high-level research -oriented university, a first-class digital finance and economics university, and a benchmark university serving Jiangxi through quality, impetus, and efficiency transformations. In 2024, it passed the "Re-accreditation of Higher Education Quality for International Students in China" by the Ministry of Education and was awarded a B level (with a validity period of 6 years).

Currently, the university has 1,441 full-time teachers, including 293 professors and 525 associate professors. There are 199 doctoral supervisors and 953 master's supervisors. It has 2 National Model Teachers, 16 experts enjoying special allowances from the State Council, 3 experts selected for the National "Hundred, Thousand, Ten - Thousand Talents Project", and 1 expert supported by the "New Century Excellent Talents Support Program" of the Ministry of Education. In the fourth round of national discipline evaluation, the university's Applied Economics was rated A- (top 10% in the country) and was selected as a "First-Class Construction Discipline in Jiangxi Province".

The university consists of 19 teaching schools, with 26,000 full-time undergraduate students, more than 6,000 postgraduate students, and over 650 full-time international students. It has established cooperative relationships with more than 160 universities and institutions in over 40 countries and regions, including the United States, the United Kingdom, Canada, and Australia.

Our university began enrolling international students in 1996 and currently hosts more than 650 international students from over 60 countries. Since undertaking foreign aid training programs commissioned by the Ministry of Commerce in 2008, the university has successfully completed 28 short-term foreign aid human resources training programs entrusted by the Ministry. These programs have covered six major fields, including financial risk management, financial and economic administration, teacher training, steel enterprise management, tax administration, and budget preparation. In total, nearly 790 government officials at various levels from 100 developing countries and international organizations have been trained. Since 2015, the university has also undertaken foreign aid academic master programs. It has organized 11 sessions of the Master program (IMIB) , enrolling 359 participants from 57 countries and regions across Asia, Africa, and Latin America.

(2) About Overseas Education School (OES)

This program is administered by the Overseas Education School, which was established in 2019 as the university's coordinating and management body for international students studying in China.

The School has established and improved a comprehensive training system offering both Chinese and English-medium instruction for international students, forming a multi-level education model ranging from Chinese language program to doctoral programs. To date, it has cumulatively educated almost 3,000 international students from 146 countries (Degree students).

(3) Living Environment and Condition

JUFE is located in Nanchang, Jiangxi, which is not only a historical cultural city but also a revolutionary heroic city in China with total areas of 7402 square kilometers and population of 6.67 million (in 2024). The price level in Nanchang is low with

average monthly consumption around 2000-3000 Yuan. Nanchang is a typical city of "hot summer and cold winter". It is hot in summer but cold in winter. Nanchang is known as one of the four "furnaces" in China with the highest temperature at 40 °C . The lowest temperature in winter in the past few years reached -3 °C . Therefore, students should prepare T-shirts and heavy coats for themselves.

JUFE has its own international student's dormitories on campus. Master's students enrolled in this program are provided with single occupancy rooms in the international student residence. The dormitories are fully equipped with facilities including air conditioning, water heaters, desks, wardrobes, cabinets, and single beds. In addition, the residence is furnished with shared kitchens and laundry rooms, offering great convenience for students' daily living.

3. Education Plan

(1) Program Structure

This program structure includes three parts, such as classroom learning, business and social survey, and the academic thesis. The minimum credits require 32 credits as follows:

★ Profiles of Faculty

The university will assign a high-quality faculty team to this program. All instructors have overseas study experience and extensive practical expertise, and have long been engaged in teaching and research in their respective fields.

(3) Teaching Methods

The language of instruction is English. Classes will incorporate a mix of lectures, seminars, case discussions, tutorials, presentations and so on. As for Business and Social Survey, Field trips will be arranged for students to visit the relevant business corporations, large-scale commodity trading markets, the representative commercial centers to gain first-hand knowledge of how governments and markets operate under various changing conditions in the reform and opening-up process of China, each time the relevant survey research report shall be submitted.

(4) Semesters

This program consists of four semesters. The first semester begins in September 2026, and students are expected to graduate by the end of June 2028. And students are entitled to have two winter vacations and one summer vacation during the program.

(5) Thesis

★ Thesis Requirement

Students are expected to bring specific research questions concerning international business management and multinational strategy to the program, as a part of thesis research preparation. In the first semester, students can choose their thesis supervisors. The type of thesis consists of academic research papers, project research report and case analysis report. The thesis is expected to combine theoretical perspectives, analytical skills and practical experiences of international business, and aiming at solving practical problems. Students must pass oral defense for the thesis.

★ Thesis Defense Requirement

A student is permitted to apply for thesis defense if he/she has received the approval with signature from his/her supervisor.

(6) Degree Requirement

After completing all credits within the prescribed time, passing the Chinese proficiency test (HSK Level 3), completing the thesis and passing the defense, and being reviewed and approved by the Degree Evaluation Committee of Jiangxi University of Finance and Economics, the Master's degree in International Business is awarded by Jiangxi University of Finance and Economics.

II. Application

1. Application Prerequisites

- (1) Applicants must be non-Chinese citizen from developing countries, who should be in good health not exceeding 45 years of age (born after 1 September 1981);
- (2) All applicants shall be in good physical and mental health with health certificates and physical examination forms issued by local public hospitals without any diseases that prohibited to enter China or to stay in China for long-term residence by Chinese laws and regulations. They should have no serious chronic diseases, such as hypertension, cardiovascular and cerebrovascular diseases, diabetes, cancer or other serious mental diseases, or infectious diseases that may cause serious harm to public health, major surgical recovery period, acute disease onset period, and severe disability of limbs. Pregnant women are not allowed to study in China. If a female student becomes pregnant during her study period in China, she will be subject to dismissal from the program.
- (3) Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree or above and have at least three years of work experience.
- (4) Applicants should have an academic or professional background related to the applied program, with preference given to those currently employed.
- (5) Applicants who are government officials with the rank of section chief or above (or correspondent rank), senior managers in various institutions or enterprises, or academic backbones of universities and research institutions can also enjoy priority of admission.
- (6) Applicants should be good at English and able to use English for professional studies with IELTS scoring 6.0 or above, or New TOEFL scoring 80 or above.
- (7) Applicant should have the potential for his /her career development, with an effort to promote the exchange and cooperation between the host country and China.

(8) Applicants who have studied in China or have been admitted to other Chinese government scholarship programs are not allowed to apply.

Note: All materials must be genuine and valid. Once false materials are found, the admission qualification will be permanently cancelled.

2. Application Procedure

(1) Online Application

Applicants who meet the above requirements can log in to the Jiangxi University of Finance and Economics International Student Enrollment Management System (website: <https://onlineapplication.jxufe.edu.cn/>) After successful registration, click on the course interface, select the International Program for Master of International Business (IMIB) , follow the steps to complete the application process, and click submit. If students have any questions during the application process, they can send an email to wangqi@jxufe.edu.cn Obtain consulting services. Please be sure to include your name and country in the email subject line to ensure prompt and accurate assistance.

(2) Instructions

- A. After completing the online electronic form, please print it out and manually sign your name and the date of filling out the form.
- B. Affix a passport-sized photo at the designated location on the printed paper form.
- C. Fill in "MOFCOM Scholarship" under the funding source section.

(4) Application Documents

Applicants are required to prepare application documents listed below. Any omission will result in refusal.

(4) Submission

- ① Students can apply for this scholarship only after being approved and recommended by the relevant responsible department of the host government, and submit the materials according to the specific requirements of the relevant department of the host country.
- ② If the government of the host country allows the students to submit the materials

directly to the Chinese embassy, the students shall submit the original paper documents of the above form and the scanned version to the Economic and Commercial Office of the Chinese Embassy of the host country with the relevant certificate or recommendation letter approved by the host country to study in China.

③ The relevant responsible department of the government of the host country requests in writing the Economic and Commercial Office to issue a letter of recommendation for the recommended students in the country, and indicates in the written request, if the quota of the university has been used up, whether to accept the transfer to other universities with the same or similar majors. If there are other special instructions to be put forward together.

Reminders:

(1) All submitted materials should be in English or Chinese. If any documents are in a language other than English or Chinese, a certified translation in English or Chinese must be provided.

(2) For important documents such as the graduation certificate, degree certificate, transcripts, and language proficiency certificates, applicants must submit not only photocopies but also the originals for verification by the commercial section of the Chinese embassy. After verification, applicants should scan and send copies of the application materials to the program admissions contact person at the respective university.

(3) Applicants should ask for all hard-copy documents back, both original copies and photocopies from the Economic and Commercial Counselor's Office. If admitted, the documents must be taken to China and presented to JUFÉ for registration.

3. Deadline

The application deadline for this program is **6 June, 2026**.

2. Others Information

(1) Scholarship recipients are not allowed to change their majors or the duration of their studies after arriving in China.

(2) Those who cannot come to study in China within the registration period will NOT have their scholarship reserved.

(3) The application documents will NOT be returned whether the applicant is admitted or not.

Part one: Program Introduction

I Brief Introduction

Academic Education Programs sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of People's Republic of China is designed to foster high-end business officials and managerial personnel for the recipient countries, offering master programs and doctoral programs for the purpose of educating high-end and inter-disciplinary talent working in the applied fields of government, trade, foreign affairs, agriculture, technology, education, culture and health, building intellectual capacity and facilitating the economic and social development of the recipient countries. These programs provide assistance to governmental officials, research fellows, and senior managerial personnel on their master and doctor education in China, which are fully conducted in English. Admission requirements include a bachelor's degree or master degree, relevant working experiences, and decent physical conditions, essential for the high-compact curriculum needed for the degrees. The programs are playing a more and more important role in stimulating economic cooperation between China and students' home countries, which the host governments are attaching great attention to this program.

MOFCOM Scholarship-CSC Program is set up by Ministry of Commerce of People's Republic of China to further strengthen the communication and cooperation between China and other countries as well as to develop talents for developing countries. Starting from 2015, MOFCOM Scholarship-CSC Program mainly sponsors the young and the middle-aged talents from recipient countries to pursue their postgraduate degree education in China. China Scholarship Council is entrusted to administer the Scholarship.

II Supporting categories

MOFCOM Scholarship-CSC Program supports Master program and PhD program.

III Educational purpose

To cultivate high-level, versatile and application-oriented talents in the fields of politics, economy and trade, diplomacy, agriculture, science, education, culture and health, energy and transportation, and public administration.

IV Enrollment Plan

Designated universities and majors of this program is included in the attachment. Length of scholarship will be settled when admission is completed, which accords to the enrolled length of schooling, which shall be 2 or 3 years for Master Recipients and 3 or 4 year for PHD Recipients. Scholarship recipients must register for English-taught program.

V Scholarship Coverage

1. Students are exempt from tuition fee, teaching material fee, research and survey fee, allowance of English-taught program, dissertation guidance fee;

2. Free on-campus accommodation;
3. Monthly stipend:
36000RMB per year per master student,
42000RMB per year per PhD student;
※ Stipends will be distributed to the students by the universities on a monthly basis according to the students' actual time spent in China.
4. One-off resettlement fee: 3000RMB per person;
5. Free medical insurance for international students;
6. One-time round-trip international airfare for all the students (First time fly to China after enrollment, and Fly back to home country while graduation), and a maximum of “n-1” (“n” is for the length of schooling year which is set while the student was enrolled by the program) round-trip international airfares for home visits (one time per year set at the end of an academic year);
7. The annual review is compulsory for all students. Those who pass the review may continue to enjoy full scholarships in the next year.
8. Other expenses shall be managed and used by the Ministry of Commerce or the universities as a whole, and shall not be distributed to students. The Ministry of Commerce only provides students with financial support within their enrolled length of schooling. Students who postpone their graduation will not receive the continuing sponsorship.

Part Two: How to Apply

I Eligibility

To be eligible, applicants must:

- be a citizen of a developing country other than the People’s Republic of China, and under the age of 45 (born after September 1, 1981);
- be healthy physically and mentally with a physical examination report issued by a local public hospital, and not having any disease or situation listed below:
 - a) Diseases prohibited by Chinese Entry-Exit Inspection and Quarantine Laws and Regulations
 - b) Other severe chronic diseases like high blood pressure, cardio-cerebrovascular disease, diabetes; psychological diseases; or other infectious diseases which may harm public health
 - c) In recovery period after major surgery or acute disease attacks
 - d) Severe physically challenged
 - e) Pregnancy (Students who become pregnant while studying in China will be expelled)
- with at least three years’ working experience, and be a bachelor’s degree holder when applying for master’s program; be a master’s degree holder when applying for doctoral program;
- be incumbents with a relevant educational background or working experience to the applied program are preferred;

- be public officials of division level and above (or corresponding level) in government sectors, or senior management staff of organizations and enterprises, or academic backbones of universities and research institutions;
- be sufficient in English which meets the academic requirements of the program, be equivalent to IELTS 6.0 or TOEFL 80 and above level;
- be with the potential of professional development, and is committed to promoting the friendly exchanges and cooperation between the host country and China;
- be neither studying in China nor being admitted to other scholarship programs provided by Chinese government.

II Application Procedures

The Economic and Commercial Counselor's Office (ECCO) of the Chinese Embassy in your country will be open for application **until 6th June 2026.**

Application Online and Documents List

1. Application Form for MOFCOM Scholarship-CSC Program;
Ensure you have both submitted it online (visit www.campuschina.org, click "Scholarship Application for Students") and printed the hard copy. For more application instructions, please check Attachment I;
2. Photocopy of highest diploma;
3. Photocopy of academic transcripts;
4. A Study Plan or Research Proposal, plus a resume including the educational background and working experience after high school;
5. Two recommendation letters, including one from current employer and one from academic perspective;
6. Photocopy of the Foreigner Physical Examination Form;
7. Photocopy of the English proficiency certificate;
8. Photocopy of a valid passport;
9. Non-criminal Record Report. The applicant shall submit a valid certificate of Non-Criminal Record issued by the local public security authority, usually issued within 6 months prior to the submission date of the application.

Submission Offline

1. The applicants shall obtain the approval and recommendation from the relevant department of host country before applying for this scholarship. Afterwards, the applicants could submit application according to the requirements of above department.
2. For the applicants whose host government allows them to submit the application directly to the Embassy of China, please obtain the permission or recommendation letter from the host government which states that the applicant has been approved to study in China, and submit the original documents of the letter and other above mentioned application documents to the ECCO of Chinese Embassy in the host country. The scanned electronic edition of the documents is needed as well. For

2. The responsible department of the host government shall submit a written request to the ECCO of Chinese Embassy for an official recommendation letter and clearly state:

- a) Whether the applicant is willing to be considered for a similar program at other universities if the applied programs could not accept the applicant.
- b) Other special requests if any.

Reminders:

- a) All the documents to be submitted should be in Chinese or English. Otherwise, a notarized copy in Chinese or English is required.
- b) An original copy of degrees, transcripts, Foreigner Physical Examination Form and language certificates must be presented for on-site verification.
- c) Applicants will get back all the hard-copy materials, both original copies and photocopies from the ECCO of Chinese Embassy. If admitted, students must take the documents to China and submit them to the university for verification and archive.
- d) Bringing spouse or other dependent for accompanying is not allowed during the students' study in China. The scholarship will not provide any related cost;
- e) No explanation will be given on the enrollment result.
- f) Applications without the recommendation from the ECCO of Chinese Embassy will not be considered.

Part Three: Placement

Each applicant can choose maximally three preferred universities out of the 26 designated universities. CSC will place each applicant in one university only on the basis of their choices and universities' requirements.

Part Four: Admission & Registration

Scholarship winners will receive the admission package from ECCO of the Chinese Embassy after the enrollment result is confirmed, and must register at the host university before the deadline which is usually September, 2026. Regarding the registration and course arrangement for enrolled candidates, please keep in touch with the host universities and closely follow their relevant notices.

Step 1: Visit “CSC Study in China” website and click “Scholarship Application for Students” at <http://www.campuschina.org>

Register an account through [CREATE AN ACCOUNT] and login with your account.

Step 2: Input Personal Details. Click “Edit Personal Details” and finish inputting personal details by filling in all the information, verifying and saving the information. After the completion of this section, return to the previous page by clicking “Finish” and start filling in your application information.

Step 3: Select the correct “Program Category”.

Please select Program Category “Type A”. **(Only for applicants of MOFCOM Scholarship-CSC Program)**

Step 4: Input the correct Agency Number.

Your Agency Number is: 00010. **(Only for applicants of MOFCOM Scholarship-CSC Program)**

Program Category and **Agency Number** are directly matched, both are mandatory for online application. Scholarship receiving authorities (or application processing authorities) will inform the program category and agency number to candidates who are qualified for applying.

After inputting agency number, the matched agency name will automatically show on the page. As **Program Category** and **Agency Number** are directly matched, application processing authorities will not receive your online application if the program category or agency number are not correct.

Step 5: Input Application Information

Next, please move on to the section of “Language Proficiency and Study Plan” and upload “Supporting Documents” as requested, then click “Submit” to complete the application. Check each part of your application carefully before submission. Please make sure that all the information and uploaded documents are valid and accurate.

When applicants of “Type A” application choose the “Preferences of Institutes”, system will automatically match the available universities according to the selected

“Student Category, Preferred teaching language”. With any inquiry concerning the available majors of each university, please visit the following website.

“Catalog of Discipline Field, First-level Discipline, Specialty” is available from the “Help”, applicants could download the file to identify the relation between Discipline and Major.

Step 6: Once submitted, amendment cannot be made on “Personal Details” and “Application Information”. Before the application being processed by the processing authorities, applicant can revoke the submitted application by clicking “Withdraw” and edit the application. After revoking the application, applicant must submit at second time after re-editing, or the application will not be processed. Once the application is processed, application cannot be revoked.

Step 7: Click” Print the Application Form” and download the form.
